//intro

The present programme builds on the **LIVING WITH EARTHQUAKES** conference held in Cambridge in October 2017, which discussed the earthquakes that affected the Apennine regions, causing widespread destruction and damage to cultural heritage.

This summer school is therefore part of a wider research initiative, involving a dialogue between the SCIENCES (Seismic Engineering, Geotechnics, Construction) and the HUMANITIES (Philosophy, Sociology, Architecture and Urban Studies, History of Art and Architecture).

The new programme is based on the successful experience of the 2018 edition held in Amandola and takes advantage of the surveys and design proposals produced and presented in the final exhibition on 1st August 2018.

//aims and strategies

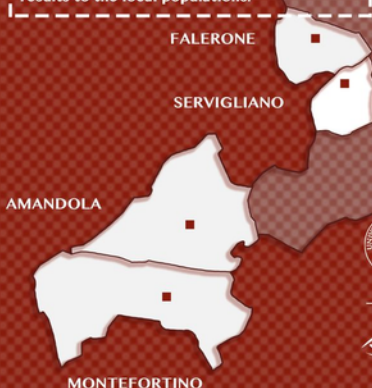
Advanced Master students and PhD candidates in landscape architecture and planning, architectural and urban design, engineering, architectural and art history, and philosophy will be based in Falerone and will make a comparative study of three hill towns in the province of Fermo: **FALERONE, AMANDOLA and MONTEFORTINO**. The town of **SERVIGLIANO** will act as hosting place for seminars and meetings.

Field studies and teaching will include:

- _understanding the urban landscape ;
- _understanding the value of the tangible and intangible heritage;
- _principles and problems in the conservation of historic fabric;
- _the use of archival material in preparing design appraisals and reports.

PARTICIPANTS WILL WORK AT URBAN DESIGN PROPOSALS ON THE SMALLS TOWNS OF Falerone, Montefortino and Amandola IN THE INNER APENNINE AREAS OF THE MARCHE REGION.

A FINAL EXHIBITION organised in Servigliano will give the opportunity to present the first results to the local populations.

13th July 2019

Opening session: guided visits to the three selected areas in Falerone, Amandola and Montefortino. Evening lecture on the context of the Province of Fermo.

14th July 2019

Studio-urban design and contextual studies in separate groups. Evening lecture on conservation principles.

15th July 2019

Studio - understanding the value and the identity of the places . Afternoon excursion to Ascoli Piceno and visit to the Archives.

16th July 2019

Studio- field study of the selected areas. Evening meeting with the Architects' and Engineers' Unions.

17th July 2019

Studio -first design proposals for the selected areas . Evening excursion to Fermo.

18th July 2019

Studio - design proposals and afternoon review. Evening meeting with local citizens.

19th July 2019

Studio - design proposals and afternoon review.

20th July 2019

Studio - final proposals and preparation for exhibition.

21st July 2019

Final exhibition and closing session.
